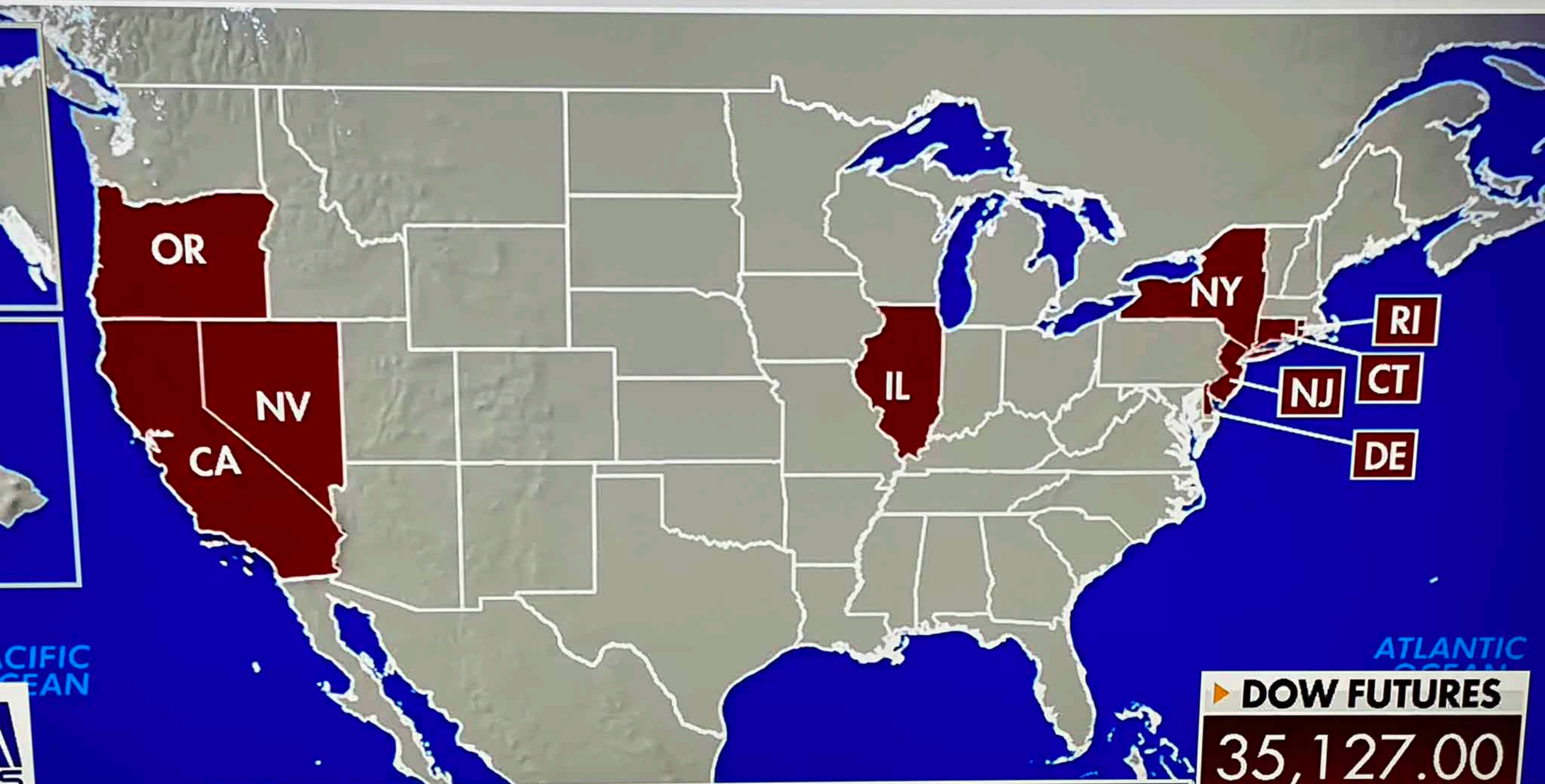

Pima County Board of Supervisors,

Please read my comments into records. Electronic voting machines pose a severe risk to the security and integrity of free and fair elections!
