Purpose: In 2026, State Grants-in-Aid funding will enable Pima County Public Library (PCPL) to further its mission of promoting literacy and community engagement. The funds will support key initiatives focused on expanding outreach, enhancing literary arts programming, and facilitating professional development to align with our evolving service model.
Term/Performance Period: July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026
Amount Awarded: \$25000

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes: PCPL will strengthen community outreach and enhance its literary arts programming to better serve the needs of Pima County residents. In 2026, PCPL aims to increase community engagement and participation at key events like the Tucson Festival of Books (TFOB) and other cultural initiatives. By fostering collaboration with local and regional authors and investing in staff professional development, the library will create more meaningful and inclusive connections that represent diverse voices.

Public Benefit and Impact: Pima County residents will directly benefit from enhanced educational, cultural, and economic opportunities through the library's active community engagement. By expanding access to diverse literary programming and investing in professional development, PCPL will continue to meet the evolving needs of the community, fostering inclusivity and cultural enrichment.

Much of PCPL programming is for all community members, but it is even more vital for those in high-poverty areas who face barriers to access, such as cost and transportation. By removing these barriers, we can ensure that these communities have the resources they need to thrive.

This will include participation rates at the Tucson Festival of Books (TFOB) and other events, as well as post-event evaluations to assess the effectiveness of outreach and programming.

Retroactive Description:	Yes. The Arizona State Library issues award notifications in August with a performance period beginning on July 1, 2025. PCPL submits the application after receiving the award notice and after application approval is granted. PCPL held a budget kickoff meeting with GMI Development and Finance Grants related to SGIA. If this award is not approved, Pima County residents will face reduced access to essential resources, and community engagement with PCPL will be diminished.
