Funding Purpose:

This intergovernmental agreement, no cost, term extension will allow Tanque Verde Fire District CDBG funds to complete the purchase, permitting and installation of, at minimum, one fire hydrant. The agency will continue to use funds appropriated in the original contact from the FY2013-2014 Pima County CDBG allocation.

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

The goal is to utilize CDBG funding is the addition of one fire hydrant to expand the Fire District's existing system.

Public Benefit:

The Tanque Verde Fire District will have increased public and fire safety for Pima County residents in their service area.

Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

- The installation of, at minimum, one fire hydrant including labor, hardware, permits, utility coordination, traffic control and excavation costs.
