***Project Title/Description:**

Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant

***Purpose:**

U.S Department of Justice Programs passed through City of Tucson to provide financial support to the Pima County Attorney's Office and the Pima County Sheriffs Department. The Pima County Attorney's Office (PCAO) will utilized it's \$77,620 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Category 2 Local Solicitation funds to hold accountable the people who are responsible for violent crimes and reducing violent crime. Specifically, grant funds was be used to support the salary and EREs of one FTE prosecutor. That bureau handles violent felony cases, including but not limited to aggravated assault, murder, attempted murder, robbery, attempted robbery and home invasions. The Pima County Sheriff's Department (PCSD) will use its \$77,621 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Category 2 Local Solicitation funding for continued support of community outreach programs – Rape Aggression Defense, and Dispose-A-Med, Shred-A-Thon to the public. For a total of \$155,241. This amendment is a no-cost extension to allow PCSD to spend the funding.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

To improve and enhance law enforcement programs related to Criminal Justice and to reduce violent crime and serious offenses by holding those responsible sufficiently, swiftly and surely accountable.

***Public Benefit:**

Greater public safety for City and County residents.

***Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

Quarterly financial and programmatic reports.

***Retroactive:**

Yes. Agreement was under review since August 24, 2023, with PCAO and COT for renewal regarding the no-cost extension. Several modifications have been made and on September 28, 2023 both parties have agreed on the agreement while continuing to operate as if the IGA was still in legal effect. On October 17, 2023 COT approved on the Mayor and Council meeting and returned the agreement to PCAO on October 31, 2023. Therefore, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the agreement to have been in effect as of the commencement date. If not approved, this will affect the public safety Pima County residents.

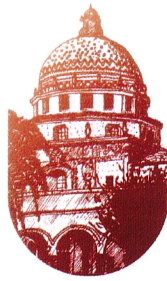

RESOLUTION NO. 23690

RELATING TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) BETWEEN THE CITY OF TUCSON (CITY) AND PIMA COUNTY FOR THE 2020 EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM AWARD; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the award period for the 2020 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (the "2020 Grant") was four years, ending September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City is the fiscal agent for the 2020 Grant, which was awarded jointly to the City and Pima County; and

WHEREAS, the County applied to U.S. Department of Justice to extend the term of the 2020 Grant for one year, to September 30, 2024, to allow Pima County to fully expend its awarded funds, and DOJ granted the extension request;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. The amendment to the IGA between the City and Pima County for the 2020 DOJ Edward Byrne JAG Program Award, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the said IGA for and on behalf of the City and the City Clerk is directed to attest the same.

SECTION 3. The various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Resolution.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City that this Resolution become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.



**AMENDMENT NO. ONE
TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
Between Pima County and the City of Tucson**

1. Background and Purpose.

- 1.1. Pima County ("**County**") and the City of Tucson ("**City**") entered into the above-referenced Intergovernmental Agreement ("**Agreement**") under which City agreed to act as the applicant and fiscal agent for the FY2020 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG and provide County \$155,241.00 in grant funds for purposes authorized under the grant.
- 1.2. County requested an extension of the grant period to allow the County to expend remaining grant funds and the Department of Justice granted the request. City and County are amending the Agreement to extend the term for a corresponding time period.

2. Term. The Term of the Agreement is hereby extended to September 30, 2024.


3. Effective Date; Counterpart Signatures. This Amendment will be effective on the date signed by both parties. This Amendment may be signed in counterparts.
