Pima County Board of Supervisors,

I am writing to you today in support of the "10 Year Regional Housing Strategy and Funding Plan" which is item # 22 on tomorrow's March 3, 2026 BOS agenda.

This plan guides spending of \$413M in regional funding, including \$250M of Pima County Affordable Housing Funds in closing the gap in the need for affordable housing and keeping people housed.

For the past 5 years, Pima County has worked with nonprofit leaders, jurisdictional and community representatives to address homelessness and affordable housing through the Pima County Affordable Housing Task Force, the P.C. Regional Affordable Housing Commission; and, with a regional housing and housing needs survey by EcoNorthwest. This comprehensive survey, determined the regional housing need and the suggested types of housing and where they need to be built. All of these efforts have two goals - to build more housing and to keep people housed. The "Pima County 10-year Regional Housing Strategy and Funding Plan" is a culmination of all of this work and will take our community to the next level in addressing this regional crisis.
