Dear Board of Supervisors,

I would like to express my concerns regarding Voting Centers and Electronic Poll Books. I strongly urge you to vote **NO** on both issues. The following are my reasons for why you need to vote **NO** on voting centers and **NO** on electronic poll books:

This proposal creates chaos by having too many changes of a process or a system at the same time. You are looking to change locations, electronic systems (two of them), and shifting of people who will need additional training.

This proposal is an absolute assault on election integrity. Common Sense would inform a person of average intelligence that depending on electronic equipment particularly that which is connected to the internet can be hacked and manipulated with very little ability to detect what has occurred on the other side of the computer screen.

Reduction of the voting polls to establish voting centers is a suppressive act of the vote. People go to the polls that is close to their own homes and where they have confidence in their neighbors that know them to count the votes as they cast them. Changing the location will lead to discourage some citizens from voting due to the extremely long lines that this act will cause.

Voting Centers will increase the opportunity for fraud as many people can choose to attempt to vote in multiple centers which would go against one person one vote and everyone having equal voice.

Implementation of printing out ballots on the day of also contributes to the chaos of more votes being cast without verification or integrity in relationship to the voting rolls.
