*Project Title/Description:

PY22/FY23 - Extension of Awarded One Time Funding Opportunities - Youth

*Purpose:

This is a Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) one-time funding opportunity amendment for July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025 for WIOA activities which include apprentice programs, work experience and training to help Pima County residents attain full-time employment. The Grant Funding Allocation for PY22/FY23 – Extension of Awarded One Time Funding Opportunities - Youth Federal Award Identification Number (FAIN) 23A55AY000011 is \$329,645.

Indirect costs: 10%

*Procurement Method:

The grant award did not require Pima County Attorney Office review or signature.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

30 students successfully complete pre-apprenticeship program and enter apprenticeships, 35 students complete 160 hours of work experience, 75 students with barriers completed 180 hours of classroom time, Community Resource Navigators increase overall recruitment and enrollment in WIOA activities and increase equitable service delivery to WIOA target populations in rural and undeserved areas.

*Public Benefit:

Fewer unemployed individuals in Pima County with decreased reliance on public benefits and more self-sufficient population.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Monthly reports to grantor.

*Retroactive:

Yes. Notice of extension was issued by AZDES on June 24, 2024 with a grant award date of July 1, 2024. The Alert could not be processed until July 15, when the department was granted access to the County's new enterprise system (Workday). For that reason, and due to a high volume of financial transactions held during the cutover period, the first available Board meeting is August 19. If the Extension of Awarded One Time Funding Opportunities is not approved, Pima County youth will not receive funding for WIOA activities which include apprentice programs, work experience and training to help them attain full-time employment.

Division of Employment and Rehabilitation Services ALERT PY22/FY23-5 - WIOA One-Time Funding Opportunity Extension

Approximately \$1.6 M is being awarded to the following five Local Workforce Development Areas to continue to support various employment and training programs as allowable under 20 CFR § 682.200 and 20 CFR § 682.210 as evaluated for allowability in accordance with 20 CFR § 682.110 and 20 CFR § 683.110 awarded through Alert 24-001: Coconino, Northeastern Arizona, Pima, Pinal, and Yuma. The following requirements apply to the awards:

- Obligations must be reported on the reimbursement reports. Any funds not obligated by May 31, 2025, must be returned to the Department of Economic Security.
- The period of performance for the funding source of these one-time funds begins July 1, 2024 and ends on June 30, 2025. Therefore goods and services must be provided/delivered, by June 30, 2025. Payment for goods and services provided/delivered outside of the period of performance of these one-time funds are not allowable.
- The final request for reimbursement must be submitted no later than July 15, 2025. Submit reimbursement requests on the invoice template as frequently as possible to WIOAfiscalreports@azdes.gov.
- All expenditures must be allowable under the cost principles and are not exempt from WIOA guidelines. For example, payments and services to individuals must be WIOA enrolled participants.
- Out of School Youth cumulative expenditures must be reported for all direct youth services within these approvals.
- Pre-approved allocations for equipment must be documented on the Department of Economic Security template and signed by each Local Workforce Development Area.
- Backup documentation and items of cost will be subject to review in future fiscal and program monitoring.
- Upon completion of the work, submit a narrative/presentation to share the results of the population benefiting from the effort, to learn from local community experience, and to showcase partnership successes. Please submit narrative/presentation to wioaprogram@azdes.gov no later than July 31, 2025.

In early June 2024, the Department of Economic Security met with each Local Workforce Development Area who received an allocation to understand the status of each project and to consider extending the time for project implementation.
