Agenda Item #18: Pima County Recorder Voter Registration Rolls Fund House Bill (HB) 2862 General Appropriations.

During the Arizona House of Representatives Fifty-fifth Legislative Session, House Bill 2862 adopted a budget for fiscal year 2023.

It contained appropriations impacting fiscal year 2023/24. On June 28, 2022, Governor Ducey signed and approved HB 2862.

In the allocations, the sum of \$6,000,000 was appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year 2023/24 to the state treasurer's office for distribution to county recorders offices...

Pima County Recorder will receive \$950,000 in funding over the next four quarters for FY2023/24 from the State Treasurer's Office.

This agenda item is to approve the use of budget authority contingency, allowing the Recorder to expend these funds to review

the accuracy of the voter registration rolls as outlined in HB 2862.

Isn't it the job of the County Recorder to keep accurate voter registration rolls? We are already paying her to do this. Why would taxpayers have to pay extra for this? We are already paying for the unauthorized 3rd party vendor ERIC and for the AVID voter roll maintenance software to clean voter rolls. This is double/triple taxation.

Runbeck's signature verification software is another unauthorized expense. When will the trove run over? Say NO to this glut.

We've had enough of the bankrupting of America!
