Requested Board Meeting Date: 11/21/2017

**Title:** Solid Waste Fee Schedule Ordinance Establishing a Fee Schedule for the 5 year period from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2023.

**Introduction/Background:**

Four years ago, Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ) transitioned County solid waste services to a private contractor, Tucson Recycling and Waste Services (TRWS). On June 2, 2013, TRWS began operating the County's solid waste facilities under contract to PDEQ. Facility entry fees are established by an ordinance approved by the Board of Supervisors. The current ordinance covers fees through June 30, 2018. A new fee schedule is necessary for future years.

**Discussion:**

The fee ordinance adopted by the Board of Supervisors establishes facility entry fees for the County's landfills and transfer stations operated by TRWS. TRWS currently operates the Ajo Landfill as well as transfer stations at Sahuarita, Ryan Field and Catalina. The current fee schedule ends June 30, 2018. This ordinance will establish commercial and residential fees for a period of five (5) years beginning July 1, 2018.

**Conclusion:**

PDEQ is proposing the new fee schedule ordinance to establish fees for a period of five (5) years beginning July 1, 2018.

**Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the Board of Supervisors adopt the proposed fee schedule ordinance. The proposed fee schedule ordinance presents changes to solid waste facilities fees, including establishing commercial and residential fees for a period of five (5) years beginning July 1, 2018. The currently adopted fee schedule ends June 30, 2018.

**Fiscal Impact:**

No direct fiscal impact to the County; however, facility entry fees are critical for the continued operation of the County's solid waste facilities by TRWS.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO SOLID WASTE; REPEALING THE EXISTING FEE SCHEDULE FOR PIMA COUNTY'S SOLID WASTE FACILITIES AND ADOPTING A NEW FEE SCHEDULE FOR PIMA COUNTY'S SOLID WASTE FACILITIES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 1 of Pima County Ordinance Number 2017- 15 is repealed on July 1, 2018.

**Section 2.** The Fee Schedule for Pima County's Solid Waste Facilities (Landfills and Transfer Stations) is adopted as follows.



## **I. SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

The Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ) is proposing revisions to Pima County's fee schedule relating to Pima County's solid waste facilities (landfills and transfer stations). The proposed fee schedule ordinance presents changes to solid waste facilities fees, including establishing commercial and residential fees for a period of five (5) years beginning July 1, 2018. The currently adopted fee schedule ends June 30, 2018.

## **II. PUBLIC NOTICE**

PDEQ published a 60-Day Public Notice of the proposed fee schedule ordinance on August 22, 2017, and a 30-Day Public Notice on September 19, 2017 (Attachment A). Public notices were prepared and submitted to local newspapers for publication. The Arizona Daily Star, Daily Territorial, and the Ajo Copper News are the three newspapers PDEQ used to publish notices. The 60-day Public Notice was also available on August 22, 2017 on the Pima County Homepage and the Pima County Proposed Taxes and Fees page, as well as the PDEQ Homepage Newsroom, and PDEQ Rulemaking Website. The 30-Day Public Notice was posted to the PDEQ Homepage Newsroom, and PDEQ Rulemaking Website on September 19, 2017. Public Notice information as well as the draft proposed ordinance are also posted on the PDEQ Rulemaking Website (Attachment A).

## **III. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

During the 30 day public comment period PDEQ did not receive comments on the proposed fee schedule ordinance.

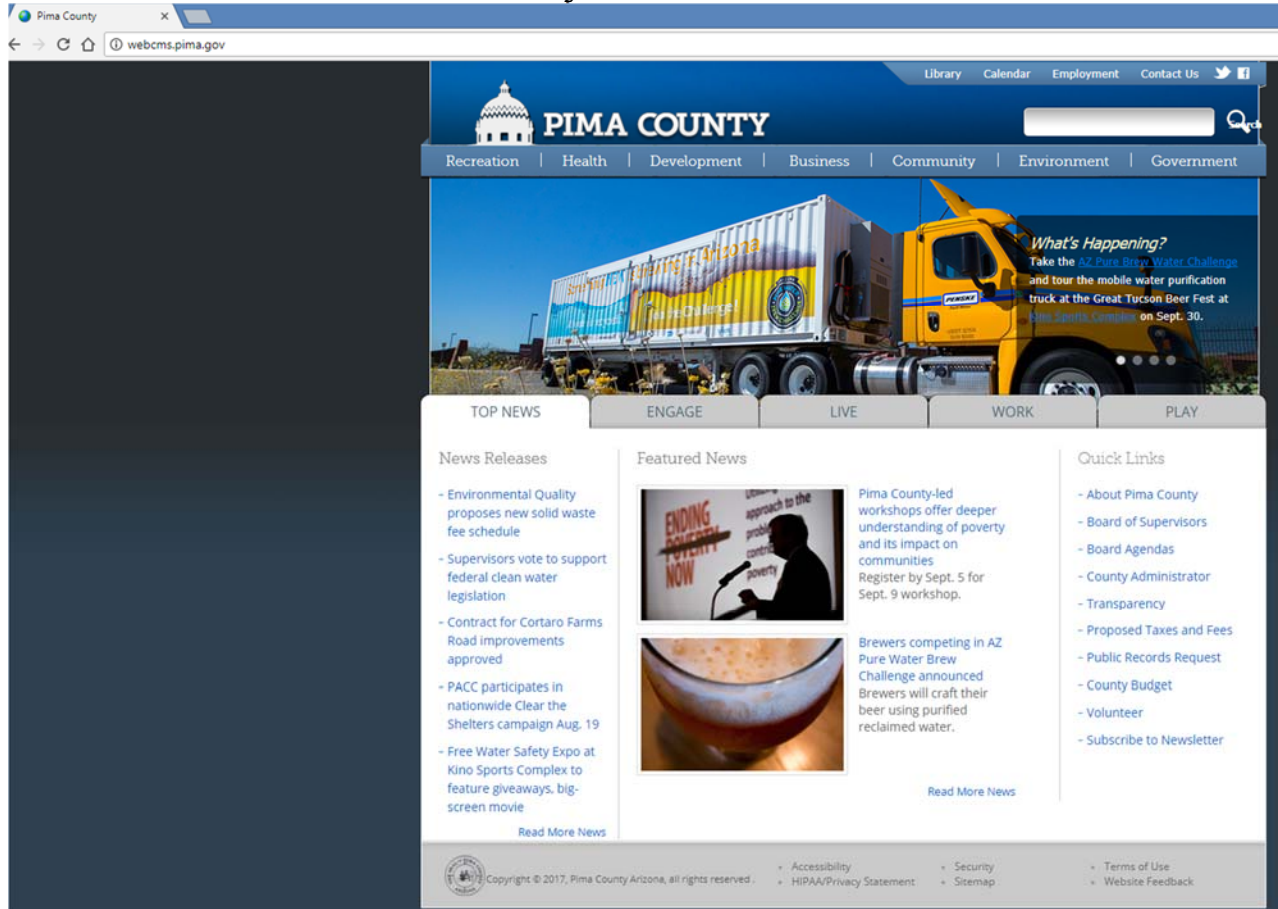

## Draft, Proposed, & Final Rules

The Arizona Revised Statutes 49-112 and 49-471 et seq. authorizes the county to adopt regulations and establishes a rulemaking process by which the county must follow. In addition, a variety of state laws give citizens the right to comment on regulations before the county can put them into effect. Pima County Department of Environmental Quality is responsible for creating and amending existing rules within Pima County Code Title 7- Environmental Quality, Title 13 - Public Service, and Title 17 - Air Quality, and creating and amending existing Pima County Ordinances relating to Air, Water, and Waste.

PDEQ follows a process for creating and amending Pima County Code and Pima County Ordinances. An [Introduction to the Rulemaking Process](#) provides an overview of the process and frequently asked questions regarding rulemaking. PDEQ also follows a process for revising the Pima County portion of the Arizona [State Implementation Plan \(SIP\)](#). Each rulemaking, or revision of the Pima County portion of the SIP will have a 30-day Public Comment period.
