*Project Title/Description:

PACC Community Cat Spay/Neuter program.

*Purpose:

Arizona Spay/Neuter provides grant funds to provide specific spay/neuter services. The \$9,500 grant was awarded for spay/neuter services for community cats in Pima County.

*Procurement Method:

The grant award did not require PCAO's review or signature.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

To provide veterinary services that include spay/neuter, ear-tipping, and rabies vaccinations. PACC estimates the grant funds will cover 158 surgeries in 2025. The funder uses the terms "Free Roaming," "Feral," and "Community Cat" interchangeably for the same category of pets.

*Public Benefit:

To expand access to preventive care for the community.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Track the number of Pima County community cats that receive preventive care.

*Retroactive:

Yes, this grant was awarded in September 24, 2024, however the official award agreement wasn't received until October 29, 2024. If this grant is not accepted, there would be a negative impact to the community because the numbers of community cats would increase significantly resulting in overpopulation and the spread of disease.

We are pleased to inform you that the Arizona Companion Animal Spay/Neuter Committee has completed its review of grant applications for the 2024-2025 Grant Period. A total of 43 programs have been selected to benefit from the \$414,600 in funds available this year.

We are excited to share that your organization has been awarded grant funds in the amount of \$ 9500 for your community Cat Spay/Neuter program. These funds are restricted for use solely in spay/neuter surgeries within Pima.

These grants are made possible through the generous support of Arizona residents who purchase the Spay and Neuter Pet Friendly License Plates and make voluntary contributions via personal income tax returns. We kindly request that you promote both the Spay and Neuter License Plates and the income tax return donation option through your newsletters, website, and any media events. We also encourage your staff to consider purchasing these plates for their own vehicles.

Grant Terms

Grant funds are available for use from the date of this notice until August 15, 2025.

Reporting Requirements

- Initial Report: The first report detailing your grant expenditures is due by April 30, 2025, or within 30 days of fully expending the funds, whichever comes first.
- Final Report: All funds must be used by August 15, 2025. The final report is due at this time and should include copies of any promotional materials for the Spay/Neuter License Plate and tax return donation option, as well as any vouchers or coupons used in the program.

FUNDING GUIDELINES and APPLICATION INFORMATION

2024/2025 GRANT CYCLE - HAS CLOSED. Next grant cycle is Aug. 2025.

Who can apply?

You may apply for a grant to fund spay and neuter services if you are a municipal/tribal animal control agency or a non-profit 501(c)3 agency, such as a humane society or other animal welfare organization. Funds will be allocated as grants to qualified applying agencies.

Grant Funding - Maximum amount of request (per project): \$10,000

- Projects available
 - Public Pets (Domesticated) Spay/Neuter Program
 - Free-roaming Cat (Feral Cat) Spay/Neuter Program
 - o Sheltered Pets Spay/Neuter Program (Government, Tribal or Nonprofit)

Total grant funding available, varies, each year. Grant funding for spay/neuter efforts throughout the state is dependent upon total proceeds from the Pet Friendly License Plate sales accumulated for the year ending June 30 and the prior year's tax donation totals.

- Awards will be announced in October and funds distributed in November/December.
- Grant funds are strictly for sterilization costs, only.
- All fifteen (15) counties are provided funding.

APPLICATION PROCESS— Though current grant cycle has closed - Information will remain on this site for future reference.

- Applications must be submitted by mail and postmarked, no later than August 31, 2024
- Only, completed packets with all applicable enclosures will be accepted.
- Approval notifications will be sent approx. October 15, 2024.

Applications are scored based on (including but not limited to)- completeness, details provided for project, the inclusion of all required documents, number of pets to be spay/neutered with requested project dollars, prior year outcomes, and more.
