Regarding Election Board Worker Appointments

Agenda Item #18 Election Board Worker Appointments Pursuant to A.R.S. §16-531(A), appointment of election board workers recruited and on file in the Elections Department for the March 19, 2024 Presidential Preference Election

ARS 16-531(A) requires the Board of Supervisors to appoint election workers for each vote center not less than twenty days before an election. The attachment provided for Agenda Item #18 provides poll workers for the vote centers. By approving the appointments provided by the Election Department, that makes both the Election Department and the Board of Supervisors in compliance with ARS 16-531(A) but does not verify any data accuracy.

I requested my name be removed from the poll worker list due to health issues and yet when Agenda #18 attachment was published in the Agenda for 3-5-24, my name continued to appear for approval. My name has now been removed and another poll worker will be assigned.

Unfortunately, the appointments for assigned work locations as represented are not accurate for many reasons: the appointments are a moving target involving many individuals personal schedules and other time consuming administrative issues. My question then is why bother approving something that is not accurate and will continue to be updated and changed? The Elections Department and Board of Supervisors should work to change the ARS 16-531(A) or clarify in the language that there is no accuracy confirmed by approval.
