Title: Temporary Road Closure Resolution

Introduction/Background:

Tucson Marathon Events, LLC has requested the temporary closure of portions of Hawser Street, Golder Ranch Drive, Coronado Forest Drive, and Twin Lakes Drive for the Tucson Marathon on Saturday, December 9, 2017 from 5:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Discussion:

As a result of the request and traffic control plan review, Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends the temporary closure of portions of Hawser Street, Golder Ranch Drive, Coronado Forest Drive, Twin Lakes Drive, and portions of the adjacent minor streets and driveways within the extent of the event, to facilitate the Tucson Marathon.

Conclusion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends the temporary closure of portions of Hawser Street, Golder Ranch Drive, Coronado Forest Drive, Twin Lakes Drive, and portions of the adjacent minor streets and driveways within the extent of the event, to enhance the safety of the Tucson Marathon by reducing potential vehicular conflicts.

RESOLUTION OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PERMITTING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF HAWSER STREET, GOLDER RANCH DRIVE, CORONADO FOREST DRIVE AND TWIN LAKES DRIVE INCLUDING PORTIONS OF THE ADJACENT MINOR STREETS AND DRIVEWAYS WITHIN THE EXTENT OF THE EVENT IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, FOR THE TUCSON MARATHON ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2017

2. Tucson Marathon Events, LLC has requested the temporary closure of portions of Hawser Street, Golder Ranch Drive, Coronado Forest Drive and Twin Lakes Drive from 5:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. to facilitate this event.

The Board of Supervisors has determined that it will be necessary to permit the temporary closure of portions of Hawser Street from Oracle Road to Coronado Forest Drive, Golder Ranch Drive from Oracle Road to Coronado Forest Drive, Coronado Forest Drive from Golder Ranch Drive to Hawser Street and Twin Lakes Drive from Golder Ranch Drive to Hawser Street to support this event.

SECTION 1. Portions of the following roadways, including portions of the adjacent minor streets and driveways within the extent of the Tucson Marathon will be temporarily closed to public traffic on Saturday, December 9, 2017 from 5:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.
