### **ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION &/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Frequency Reconfiguration Agreement between Pima County and Nextel West Corporation aka Sprint Corporation is established to provide professional services required to complete the federally mandated 800 MHz Rebanning Project. In January of 2014, the Board approved the Information Technology Department to begin negotiations with Nextel Operations in preparation for this project (Planning Funding Agreement, #CTN-IT-14\*0104). The IT Department has now successfully negotiated and finalized the Reconfiguration Agreement with Nextel West Corp. aka Sprint Corporation to provide needed professional services to ensure the County complies with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Report and Order, FCC 04-168, in WT Docket 02-55 as modified in the Supplemental Order, FCC 04-294 (together, "the Report and Order"). In accordance with the Report and Order, all costs associated with this project are borne by Nextel/Sprint. Due to the nature of the project and federal requirements, the term of the Agreement is "upon completion".

Nextel West Corporation will provide professional services to complete the mandatory 800 MHz Rebanding Project in order for the County to comply with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Report and Order, FCC 04-168, in WT Docket 02-55 as modified in the Supplemental Order, FCC 04-294 (together, "the Report and Order"), and will reimburse Pima County for all costs associated with the project, currently estimated at \$104,375.60.

**IF DENIED:**

Nextel West Corporation will not be allowed to provide professional services to complete the mandatory 800 MHz Rebanding Project. This will result in the County having difficulty completing the project to comply with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Report and Order, FCC 04-168, in WT Docket 02-55 as modified in the Supplemental Order, FCC 04-294 (together, "the Report and Order"), and the County will be in violation of the FCC order.
