RESOLUTION NO. 23923

RELATING TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS (IGA) AND PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE EXISTING IGA BETWEEN THE CITY OF TUCSON (CITY) AND PIMA COUNTY TO EXTEND THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF AGREEMENT AN ADDITIONAL FIVE YEARS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Tucson and Pima County entered into a cooperative agreement, in 2010, for the purpose of jointly providing street naming and addressing services, for the City;

WHEREAS, the IGA has been amended twice to extend the effective date of the Agreement to maintain the uniformity in street naming and addressing, which eliminates inconsistencies; and

WHEREAS, the City and County's third amendment extends the IGA an additional five years, to allow the County to continue to provide street naming and addressing services to the City.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The amendment to the IGA between the City and Pima County to provide street naming and addressing services to the City, attached as Exhibit A, is authorized and approved.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute said Amendment to the IGA and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest the Mayor's signature.

SECTION 3. The various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Resolution.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Tucson that this Resolution become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

THIRD AMENDMENT EXTENDING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PIMA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF TUCSON FOR STREET NAMING AND ADDRESSING SERVICES

This Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment is entered into by and between Pima County, a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona ("County") and City of Tucson ("Tucson") pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-952.

Recitals

- A. On July 6, 2010, the County and Tucson entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") to establish the authority for the creation of addresses to property and improvements within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City.
- B. On July 7, 2015, the County and Tucson agreed to extend the IGA an additional five years.
- C. The County and Tucson subsequently agreed to extend the IGA for an additional five year term, expiring on July 7, 2025, pursuant to a second amendment of the IGA.
- D. The County and Tucson now desire to extend the IGA for an additional five years, with further renewals upon the written agreement of the parties.

Agreement

Therefore, the County and Tucson mutually agree as follows:

- 1. The IGA is extended for an additional five years, effective July 7, 2025 and terminating July 7, 2030, unless, prior to the expiration of the period, extended or terminated by agreement of the parties.
- 2. All other terms and provisions of the IGA shall continue in full force and effect.

In witness whereof, the County has caused this Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment to be executed by the Chairman of its Board of Supervisors and attested to by the Clerk of the Board, and City has caused this Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment to be executed by the Mayor upon resolution of the Mayor and Council and attested to by:
