Title: Sunset Road Speed Limit Ordinance

Introduction/Background:

The Sunset Road project is near completion which connects Silverbell Road to Interstate 10 via a bridge spanning over the Santa Cruz River.

Discussion:

As part of the Sunset Road project, a new segment of Sunset Road was installed from Silverbell Road to Interstate 10. The design of this segment of Sunset Road included a 35 mph posted speed limit.

Conclusion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends a 35 mph speed limit be established on Sunset Road from Silverbell Road to Interstate 10. Ordinance 2010-047 is recommended to be repealed in order to consolidate the remaining Sunset Road speed limits. The remaining speed limits remain unchanged.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance for the establishment of a 35 mph speed limit on Sunset Road from Silverbell Road to Interstate 10 and the repeal of Ordinance 2010-047.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ESTABLISHING PRIMA FACIE REASONABLE SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON SUNSET ROAD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627, 28-701 and 28-703, as amended, to fix prima facie reasonable speed limits on through highways, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined the prima facie reasonable speed limits for motor vehicles on portions of Sunset Road,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit for motor vehicles on Sunset Road shall be established as follows:

<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
a) 35 mph	200 feet south of Park Ridge Road	1320 feet west of Camino De Oeste (Town of Marana Limits)
b) 35 mph	540 feet west of Silverbell Road	West line of Silverbell Road
c) 35 mph	East Line of Silverbell Road	Interstate 10 (ADOT Limits)
d) 35 mph	Kain Avenue	Oracle Jaynes Station Road

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2010-047 is repealed and all other ordinances or parts of

ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highways herein listed giving notice of the prima facie reasonable speed limits.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ESTABLISHING PRIMA FACIE REASONABLE SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON SUNSET ROAD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined the prima facie reasonable speed limits for motor vehicles on portions of Sunset Road,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit on Sunset Road be established as follows:

	<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
a)	35 mph	200 feet south of Park Ridge Road	1320 feet west of Camino De Oeste (Town of Marana Limits)
b)	35 mph	540 feet west of Silverbell Road (Town of Marana Limits)	West line of Silverbell Road
c)	35 mph	Kain Avenue	Oracle Jaynes Station Road

SECTION 2. Ordinances 2003-051 and 1992-099 Section 1 (381-382) are repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highways herein listed giving notice of the prima facie reasonable speed limits.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.


