

SALES REVENUE AGREEMENT

1. Parties, Background and Purpose.

- 1.1. <u>Parties</u>. This Contract is between Pima County, a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona ("<u>County</u>"), and Friends of PACC ("<u>Customer</u>").
- 1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. County and Customer have agreed that County open a PACC adoption satellite location on the east side of Pima County.

2. Term.

- 2.1. <u>Initial Term</u>. The term of this Contract commences on November 1, 2025, and will terminate on October 31, 2027 ("<u>Initial Term</u>"). "Term," when used in this Contract, means the Initial Term plus any exercised extension options under Section 2.2. If the commencement date of the Initial Term is before the signature date of the last party to execute this Contract, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the Contract to have been in effect as of the commencement date.
- 2.2. Extension Options. County may renew this Contract for up to four (4) additional periods of up to 1 year each (each an "Extension Option"). An Extension Option will be effective only upon execution by the Parties of a formal written amendment.
- 3. **Scope of Services**. County will provide Customer with the materials or services described in **Exhibit A** (1 page), at the dates and times described on **Exhibit A**.

4. Payment.

- 4.1. <u>Rates; Adjustment.</u> Customer will pay County as set forth in **Exhibit B** (1 page). Any rates in Exhibit B will remain in effect during an Extension Option period unless County notifies Customer in writing of any adjustments to those rates.
- 4.2. <u>Sales Taxes</u>. The payment amounts or rates in **Exhibit B** do not include sales taxes. County may invoice Customer for sales taxes that County is required to pay under this Contract. County will show sales taxes as a separate line item on invoices.
- 4.3. <u>Timing of Invoices</u>. County will invoice Customer on a monthly basis. Customer must pay the invoices within 30 days of date of invoice.

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- 5. **Choice of Law and Venue**. The laws and regulations of the State of Arizona govern the rights and obligations of the parties under this Contract. Any action relating to this Contract must be filed and maintained in the appropriate court of the State of Arizona in Pima County.
- 6. **Assignment**. Customer may not assign its rights or obligations under this Contract, in whole or in part, without the County's prior written approval. County may withhold approval at its sole discretion.
- 7. **Authority to Contract**. Customer warrants its right and power to enter into this Contract.
- 8. **Full and Complete Performance**. The failure of either party to insist, in one or more instances, upon the other party's full and complete performance under this Contract, or to take any action based on the other party's failure to fully and completely perform, is not a waiver or relinquishment of the right to insist upon full and complete performance of the same, or any other covenant or condition, either in the past or in the future. The acceptance by either party of sums less than may be due and owing it at any time is not an accord and satisfaction.
- 9. Cancellation for Conflict of Interest. This Contract is subject to cancellation for conflict of interest pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-511, the pertinent provisions of which are incorporated into this Contract by reference.

10. Termination.

- 10.1. Without Cause. County or Customer may terminate this Contract at any time, without cause, by serving a written notice upon the other Party at least 30 days before the effective date of the termination. In the event of such termination, Customer's obligation to County will be payment for materials and services rendered prior to the date of termination.
- 10.2. <u>With Cause</u>. County may terminate this Contract at any time without advance notice and without further obligation to Customer when County finds Customer to be in default of any provision of this Contract.
- 11. **Notice**. Any notice required or permitted to be given under this Contract must be in writing and be served by personal delivery or by certified mail upon the other party as follows:

- 12. **Non-Exclusive Contract**. Customer understands that this Contract is nonexclusive and is for the sole convenience of County. County reserves the right to sell like materials and services to other parties for any reason.
- 13. **Remedies**. Either party may pursue any remedies provided by law for the breach of this Contract. No right or remedy is intended to be exclusive of any other right or remedy and each is cumulative and in addition to any other right or remedy existing at law or at equity or by virtue of this Contract.

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- 14. **Severability**. Each provision of this Contract stands alone, and any provision of this Contract found to be prohibited by law will be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition without invalidating the remainder of this Contract.
- 15. **Amendment**. The parties may modify, amend, alter or extend this Contract only by a written amendment signed by the parties.
- 16. **Entire Agreement**. This document constitutes the entire agreement between the parties pertaining to the subject matter it addresses, and this Contract supersedes all prior or contemporaneous agreements and understandings, oral or written.
