ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION &/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This item is a routine correction of the Pima Regional Trail System Master Plan. The correction involves taking the TO22 Pantano Trail from Houghton to Colossal Cave Road and moving it up in classification from *trail* status to the RP03 Pantano *River Park* the entire length of the Pantano Wash. The trail was designated as a river park in the last master plan (1989), and will be a river park for its entirety again in the current plan (2011) if the correction is approved.

Modification:

Pantano River Park (RP-003). The Pantano Wash on the Pima Regional Trail System Master Plan (2011) is approximately 20.2 miles in total length, from Craycroft Road to Colossal Cave Road. In the Pima Regional Trail System Master Plan, there is conflicting language that describes another facility, the Pantano Wash Trail (TO22), which overlaps the Pantano River Park from Houghton Road to Colossal Cave Road. This amendment would eliminate the Pantano Wash Trail from the Pima Regional Trail System Master Plan to make the Pantano a 20.2 mile-long River Park for its *entirety*, the way it was in the last Trails Plan. This modification would allow that to happen.
