PY24/FY25 - Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I Funding Allocations - Rapid Response

*Purpose:

The US Department of Labor awarded the Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES) WIOA funds for workforce development activities statewide. AZDES distributes WIOA funds to Local Workforce Development Area Pima County for local area workforce development activities and programs administered by Pima County Community & Workforce Development Department. ADES WIOA IGA DI23-002389 for the term of 7/1/2023 to 6/28/2028 was approved by the Pima County Board of Supervisors on 6/20/2023. This amendment is to allocate funds for PY24/FY25 to Pima County for the purpose of providing ARIZONA@WORK Pima County One-Stop activities to job seekers that include job search assistance, pre-employment workshops, case management, occupational skills training, apprenticeships, and supportive services. The Grant Funding Allocation for PY24/FY25 WIOA Rapid Response Federal Award Identification Number (FAIN) 23A55AW000049 is \$490,080.00.

The grant award did not require Pima County Attorney Office review or signature.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

The goal is to provide workforce development activities to provide a skilled workforce to meet employer needs.

*Public Benefit:

Participating residents earn industry credentials that provide employers with a qualified workers for good quality jobs.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

WIOA performance measures include an annual metrics necessary to meet formula funding compliance employment at second and fourth quarter after exit, measureable skill gains, average median wage at exit, and number of industry recognized credentials earned. Community & Workforce Development further records activities and programming for the business community.

*Retroactive:

Yes, date of the award is for program year 2024 beginning July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025. On July 10, 2024 the county received the PY24/FY25 – WIOA Title I Funding Allocations Alert. The Alert could not be processed until July 15, when the department was granted access to the County's new enterprise system (Workday). For that reason, and due to a high volume of financial transactions held during the cutover period, the first available Board meeting is August 19. If the Rapid Response Funding Allocation is not approved, Pima County job seekers would not receive workforce development activities which include job search assistance, pre-employment workshops, case management, supportive services, occupational skills training, apprenticeships, and supportive services.

Division of Employment and Rehabilitation Services ALERT PY24/FY25-1,2,3,4 - WIOA Adult, Dislocated Worker, Youth, Rapid Response (DW)

In accordance with the Department of Labor (DOL) Employment and Training Administration (ETA), Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 12-23, Arizona received an allotment of \$72,897,578 in Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act funds.

Local Workforce Development Areas are provided with WIOA Title I funding for the Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth Programs totalling \$54,884,003 distributed based on the allocation formula approved by the Workforce Arizona Council in May 2024.

Funding is also allocated to support rapid response totalling \$6,371,040. The purpose of rapid response is to "promote economic recovery and vitality by developing an ongoing, comprehensive approach to identifying, planning for, responding to layoffs and dislocations, and preventing or minimizing the impact of layoffs of dislocations on workers, businesses, and communities." [20 CFR § 682.300(b)]. <u>List of elements</u> of a successful rapid response system.

Period of Availability for Expenditure of WIOA Title I Funds:

Pursuant to 20 CFR 683.110, funds allocated by a State to a LWDA under subpart - A sections 128(b) and 133(b), for any Program year are available for expenditure only during that program year and the succeeding program year. Funds that are not expended by a LWDA in the two-year period described in paragraph (b) (1) of section 128 (b) and 133(b) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act shall be returned to the State. Funds so returned are available for expenditure by State and local recipients and sub recipients only during the third program year of availability. These funds may be used for statewide projects or distributed to other LWDAs, which had fully expended their allocation of funds for the same program year within the two-year period.

Reports will be pulled from the system of record, so please ensure that data pertaining to the service provision and other relevant activities have been entered in accordance with the IGA.
