Title: Curtis Road and Shannon Road All-Way Yield

Introduction/Background:

The reason for this ordinance is to establish Curtis Road and Shannon Road as an all-way-yield intersection.

Discussion:

A safety project was recently completed to slow traffic and reduce crashes on Curtis Road; it included the installation of speed tables, the implementation of all-way stop control at Davis Avenue, and the installation of a mini roundabout at Shannon Road.

Conclusion:

A safety project to slow speeds and reduce crashes on Curtis Road has been constructed. This project included the installation of a mini roundabout at Curtis Road and Shannon Road, which is an all-way yield type of intersection. This ordinance will officially designate the intersection of Curtis Road and Shannon Road as an all-way-yield intersection.

Recommendation:

The Pima County Traffic Engineering Division recommends that the intersection of Curtis Road and Shannon Road be designated as an all-way-yield intersection.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF CURTIS ROAD AND SHANNON ROAD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-855 as amended, to designate and establish yield intersections and to erect yield signs, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is necessary for the protection and convenience of the traveling public of Pima County, Arizona, to establish the intersection of Curtis Road and Shannon Road as an all-way-yield intersection,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The intersection of Curtis Road and Shannon Road be designated an all-way-yield intersection.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 1971-051 Section 2 Item 8 is repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that yield signs are posted on the intersecting streets.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.


