CONTRACT AMENDMENT #9

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

- 1. Background and Purpose.
 - 1.1. Background. On August 25, 2020, County and Contractor entered into the above referenced agreement to provide representation of Pima County in Taylor v. Pima County, et al.
 - 1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. County requires continuing services and requires additional time to perform those services, commencing August 24, 2025.
- 2. Term. The County is exercising the fifth extension option to renew the contract for one additional year commencing on August 24, 2025 and terminating on August 23, 2026. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.
- Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan. Pursuant to Pima County Procurement 3. Code 11.40.030, Contractor hereby warrants that if Contractor's employees perform work in an outdoor environment under this Contract, Contractor will keep on file a written Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan. At County's request, Contractor will provide a copy of this plan and documentation of heat safety and mitigation efforts implemented by Contractor to prevent heat-related illnesses and injuries in the workplace. Contractor will post a copy of the Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan where it is accessible to employees. Contractor will further ensure that each subcontractor who performs any work for Contractor under this Contract complies with this provision.

All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.
