PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity Tucson celebrated its 45th anniversary on April 23, 2025, marking over four decades of dedicated service to Pima County by providing safe, affordable housing to families in need; and

WHEREAS, since its founding in 1980, Habitat for Humanity Tucson has built and repaired homes for thousands of individuals and families, fostering stability, hope, and opportunity for countless residents of Southern Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity Tucson has brought together volunteers, donors, and community partners to create sustainable solutions to the housing crisis, embodying the spirit of collaboration and compassion that defines our community; and

WHEREAS, through its programs and initiatives, Habitat for Humanity Tucson has strengthened neighborhoods, empowered families, and contributed to the economic and social vitality of our region; and
