#### \*Purpose:

On January 1, 2022, \$5,340,676.00 of American Rescue Plan Act/Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (ARPA/CLFRF) were awarded to Pima Community College District for the purchase of equipment and software to enhance job training programs and partnership with Subrecipient to include health, Information Technology, and infrastructure programs. In March of 2024, Pima Community College provided Grants Management and Innovation a revised budget for Project #4 Adult Education that included a \$626,488.28 reduction in funds that will not be spent by the time the grant ends on 12/31/2024. This amendment reflects a voluntary reduction of these funds along with previous modifications to budgets made at the request of Pima Community College District to their seven projects.

#### \*Procurement Method:

This Subrecipient Agreement is a non-Procurement contract and not subject to Procurement rules.

## \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

Prioritize and Scale Up Micro-Pathways which are short-term programs (i.e., 6 months or less) that lead directly into in-demand jobs with family-sustaining wages within Pima County. The micro-pathways were co-designed by Pima Community College District in partnership with regional business and industry partners and include embedded industry-recognized certifications.

#### \*Public Benefit:

Responding to the negative economic impacts of COVID-19 includes investment in job training programs for displaced workers, unemployed and low-income individuals.

## \*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Monthly project performance reports with performance benchmark indicators.

#### SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

## 1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE.

- 1.1. <u>Background</u>. On January 1, 2022, Pima County and Subrecipient (Pima Community College District) entered into the above referenced agreement to provide job training programs for displaced workers, unemployed and low-income individuals. American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding has been allocated to the purchase of equipment and software to enhance job training programs and partnerships with the subrecipient to include health, information technology, and infrastructure programs.
- 1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. This amendment reflects a budget modification that was requested by Pima Community College and approved by Pima County Grants Management and Innovation. This amendment reflects a voluntary reduction to Project #4 Adult Education budget in the amount of \$626,488.28. In addition, budget line-item modifications to the other projects are reflected in the Exhibit A budget tables. The term of the agreement remains January 1, 2022 and will terminate December 31, 2024. The commencement of this amendment will be 05/07/2024.

#### 2. **COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT.**

- 2.1. Section 5.1 Not-to-Exceed Amount. The maximum amount the County will spend under this Agreement, set forth in the initial agreement (approved April 5, 2022), is decreased by \$626,488.28. County's total payments to Subrecipient under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$4,714,187.72.
- 2.2. Exhibit A. Pima County Grants Management and Innovation has revised and replaced the budget tables in Exhibit A with the budget tables in attached Exhibit A-1 (5 pages). All other provisions of Exhibit A remain in effect. This budget will remain in effect throughout the term unless otherwise adjusted and formally agreed to.

All other provisions of the Agreement not expressly modified in this Amendment will remain in effect and be binding on the parties.
