Amendment Amount: \$15,000.00 (increases original contract from \$73,235.00 to \$88,235.00)

Term End Date: 06/30/15

Funding Source: Funding is from the Arizona Community Action Association (ACAA) a state non-profit agency which manages private housing assistance funds on behalf of several Arizona utility companies. Additional funds are available in the current revenue contract with ACAA and there is a continuing need for repair services.

Purpose: To provide emergency home repair services for low-income families. *The purpose of this amendment is to increase the contract amount and the number of services required.*

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes: The number of households to be served will increase from 141 to 154 under this amendment.

Public Benefit: Assists in alleviating poverty, revitalizing communities and empowering low-income families to become self-sufficient.

Metrics available to Measure Performance: CSBG required Results-Oriented Management and Accountability (ROMA) reporting.
