Hello,

We are reaching out as parents of two elementary age children to implore you to vote to mandate masks in school.

While the teacher of one of our children has shared that she is vaccinated, consistently wears a mask and is following mitigation practices. The teacher of our high risk child is unwilling to share her vaccination status, not wearing a mask, has children facing each other at tables and is hugging the students. All of the other teachers in the same grade level are maskless which leaves us no better option than unenrolling our kids and choosing an online program for them.

As parents we feel our hands are tied in the safety and development of our own children and this is not okay. We either have to risk our children getting sick and possibly being hospitalized or losing important social and educational skills that are being learned at this critical point in their lives.

We have had meetings and emailed our district yet it all seems to lead nowhere and quite frankly seems as though our district would chose to pretend we are not in a pandemic and risking the lives of our community members daily. The school year started with emails home regarding cases however those have stopped as to not raise alarm for the parents.

We cannot continue to pretend this pandemic is not affecting people daily and infecting more and more children whom we are all putting at risk by leaving it up to each parent instead of listening to the many medical experts including the American Academy of Pediatrics.

We are grateful that the Pima County board has chosen to implement a mask mandate at the county buildings protecting adults and community members and am hopeful that you will now choose to vote for a mask mandate in schools in order to protect our vulnerable children who are not yet old enough to get vaccinated. Also, please keep in mind that our children are stuffed in a room (30 kids in one of my kids' class) unmasked and in harms way.

We are hopeful that the lawsuits working to change the mask mandate ban are successful but in the time waiting for them to go through the system how many children will become sick, hospitalized and possibly die while we sit around doing nothing?
