The stated purpose of this project is to "construct roadway curbs and sidewalks along both sides of Palo Verde Road from south of Gas Road to north of Columbia Street. This project will be funded by \$2,006,000 of federal Regional

Transportation Alternatives Grants (RTAG) funds with the required local match provided by \$322,000 of RTA funds." This covers about half of a mile of Palo Verde Road just north of I-10. The improvement would be welcome, but does

it require nearly \$2.5 million of taxpayer dollars and 2.5 years to complete?
