Evaluation services will be provided by Lecroy & Milligan Associates.

Averhealth and the Amity Foundation are trusted Pima County Attorney's Office contractors who have provided services for the CMPS Court program participants since it was established in 2018. The addition of restorative justice services late in the CMPS treatment cycle is meant to give participants a final push in their individual recoveries and reduce recidivism, as the program's other services wind down for each participant.

An important program enhancement would be staff and volunteer training by The Center for Community Medication and Facilitation, the only vendor in the Tucson area specialized in culturally sensitive restorative justice services. This agency used to be merged with Our Family Services, the previous named contractor.

Changes will reflect the following for all three years:

## Procurement:

Restorative Justice Training to be completed by The Center for Community Mediation and Facilitation Evaluation Services to be provided by Lecroy & Milligan Associates Employment services were removed with \$5,000 X3 reallocated.

## Subawards:

CBI will have \$5,000 added for screening, assessment, intake each year (3), this was taken from employment services due to multiple community resources available and sufficient.
