**Comment** Hello, I work at the public library for Pima County. Yesterday, I had around half a dozen interactions with very angry, very confrontational patrons coming in either refusing masks, and or refusing temperatures. At my very small library, this is more than I have ever encountered. I cannot imagine how much worse it is going to get. Our patrons, including reports from fellow co-workers at other libraries, say that the maskless patrons are at times scaring them- we have daily faced patrons at libraries with mental health issues for years, it's part of our job, but this is something that is absolutely draining me on a level I cannot put into words. I have spent the last year suffering great mental depression and exhaustion, I've used up all of my leave into January during our shut down and lost pay, and I'm hurting. I can barely call out sick anymore. I'm a Library Associate- I'm a nerd, I'm a geek, I'm introverted, and I read- and I may sum up most library staff who are story time experts, teen youth programmers, and shy and sweet people, who now spend our entire day enforcing each patron walking in to put on a mask, being berated by them, worrying for our safety (and our health, even if we have been vaccinated like I have) and trying to keep order. On top of patrons not wearing masks, and pulling them down throughout their visit, we also have to make them take their temperatures. These two combinations have burned me out to a point that I sit at home now on my time off panicking about going back to work. I don't think I enjoy my job anymore, because my job is enforcing mask wearing and temps with patrons who I am petrified of. And I've dealt with lockdown situations in libraries and witnessed fights and been threatened before at other branches. I'm writing on my own- my own email, outside of work time, because I am appealing to you, to the Board, for help. I understand the science, I understand why the mask enforcement is still happening. But I'm struggling and so are so many of my co-workers. I can't believe I was hoping to hear that at least the mask ordinance would go away for patrons during the Board meeting, and I'm as pro-mask as they come, but I can't take this. Patrons are fed up with the masks and the temps and I'm hurting. Please help us.
