Dear Supervisors;

I am a resident of Academy Village just off Old Spanish Trail. I have had the privilege of living close enough to the Saguaro National Park that I can enjoy the view from my home and walk its trails regularly. Frequently the wildlife from the Park traverse the wash behind my home. I have an environmental sciences background both by education and occupation and believe fervently in the value of our national parks and the protection of their flora and fauna for future generations. It is unfortunate that the Park is restricted primarily to the Rincon Mountains and does not include more of the low elevation areas and washes so vital to wildlife. Over the years development has crept up to the Park boundaries. The County to its credit has reduced zoning density and created the Buffer Overlay Zone to try and mitigate the impacts. Unfortunately the current level of development under these guidelines has led to degradation of habitat in the surrounding areas.

I have looked at the Bike Ranch proposal, the supporting reports, and letters from the Park Superintendent and nearby neighbors. I have concluded that given the current zoning that this is the most environmentally sensitive way to develop this property and maximize the habitat value for the Park. The reasons for this conclusion are:

- It protects 68% of the property as open space which is more than double the amount required with residential development.
- The residential homes are clustered with minimal “developed” areas around each to maximize open space.
- It has committed to landscaping an additional 14% of the site in native vegetation.
- The traffic impacts are less than if the property were developed as residential and rental properties allowed per current zoning.
- It exceeds setback requirements required under the Overlay Zone.
- It preserves the riparian area on the south side of the property.

The proposal also includes a number of other community benefits including attracting tourism \$\$, hiring 50 full time employees, creating construction jobs, purchasing goods and services, and generating additional sales and property tax revenues. These will all add to the health and vitality of our community.
