Term: August 12, 2014 to August 12, 2016

Funding Source: Department of Transportation General Fund

Project: This contract is for the County to receive legal advice and representation as needed to assist with resolving contractual issues and potential litigation related to certain road projects for the Department of Transportation.

Reason for new Amendment: To increase the contract amount to allow payment as needed for legal services during the continued term of the Contract.

Costs History: The Original contract was not to exceed \$50,000.00. Amendment 01 will increase the contract another \$50,000.00 making the new not to exceed amount \$100,000.00.

Background Information: Mesch, Clark & Rothschild, PC. have been providing legal advice and representation on behalf of Pima County and its Department of Transportation regarding certain road projects including: (1) Magee Road Improvements: La Canada Drive to Oracle Rd., PCDOT #4MRLCO; (2) La Canada Rd.: River Road to Ina Road, PCDOT #4LCRRI; and (3) Homer Davis Elementary School Transportation Enhancement Project, PCDOT #4HDBPE.

Public Benefit: Resolution of outstanding issues between the County and Select Development on terms that protect the public interest.

Metrics available to Measure Performance: Pima County attorneys continue to work closely with key personnel from Mesch, Clark & Rothschild to protect Pima County interests. Mesch, Clark & Rothschild performs work as assigned by the Pima County Attorney's Office. Monthly invoices for legal services submitted by Mesch, Clark & Rothschild are reviewed by the Pima County Attorney's Office and approved only if they comport with the assigned tasks.
