ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION and/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - ____, An ordinance of the Pima County Board of Supervisors, regulating traffic at the intersection of Deaver Road and Illinois Street in Pima County, Arizona. Staff recommends **APPROVAL**. (District 3)

The reason for this ordinance is to authorize enforcement of a stop condition on Illinois Street at Deaver Road.

A traffic study determined that, due to sight distance restrictions, a stop sign is warranted for westbound traffic on Illinois Street at Deaver Road. This ordinance will require westbound traffic on Illinois Street to stop for northbound/southbound traffic on Deaver Road. For the safety of the traveling public, a stop sign has been installed prior to the passing of this ordinance.





AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF DEAVER ROAD AND ILLINOIS STREET IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-855 as amended, to designate and establish stop intersections and to erect stop signs, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is necessary for the protection and convenience of the traveling public of Pima County, Arizona, to establish the intersection of Deaver Road and Illinois Street as a stop intersection,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The intersection of Deaver Road and Illinois Street be designated a stop intersection with traffic on Illinois Street stopping for traffic on Deaver Road.

SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that stop or yield signs are posted on the intersecting streets.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.


