PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, S-cuk Şon, inhabited for millennia, has a long history and is the birthplace of modern Tucson; and

WHEREAS, Tucson is celebrating the 250th anniversary of the founding of Presidio San Agustín del Tucson and honoring over 4,000 years of rich history, heritage, and culture of Tucson and Pima County; and

WHEREAS, we recognize how the founding of Presidio San Agustín del Tucson in 1775 shaped Tucson's trajectory and how that influence continues today. The plus (+) honors the Indigenous people and diverse communities that shaped the region long before and after its founding; and

WHEREAS, this anniversary is an opportunity to reflect on the intersection of hope, resilience, and human endeavor—among those who sought to establish a new frontier and those whose lives were deeply tied to the land; and

WHEREAS, the Tucson 250+ Celebration on August 23, 2025, at the Presidio San Agustin del Tucson, is a time to come together to commemorate Tucson's history and look forward to its bright future; and

WHEREAS, the 250+ Celebration is a once-in-a-generation event that provides a sense of unity and pride among residents by accentuating the diverse nature of the people of Tucson, Pima County, and the Tribal Nations who are caretakers of the land from time immemorial; we celebrate our heritage that reminds our community of the need to leave a lasting legacy of stewardship for generations to come.
