Dear Pima County Supervisors,

I write to apply for the position of Pima County Justice of the Peace, Precinct 6. I meet all the posted minimum requirements: I am older than 18; I am a resident of Arizona; I am an elector in the precinct in which the duties of the office are to be exercised; I am literate in English; and I am a registered Democrat.

I had the honor of representing the people of Justice Precinct 6 for twelve years in the Arizona Legislature, earning their support in the elections of 2006, 2008, 2010, 2012, 2014, and 2016. Should I earn from you the honor of appointment as a justice, I look forward to doing my job and serving the people best I can, and then running for re-election in 2026, 2028, and beyond.

I'm not an attorney, but I spent 12 years making laws. I listened to conflicting testimony in countless committee hearings and made decisions about which arguments were most persuasive to win my vote. I spent hours at the feet of knowledgeable staff learning the ins and outs of the Arizona Revised Statutes to understand legislative intent, the difference between "shall" and "may", and the many ways small changes can make a large difference in interpretation and effectiveness. I listened carefully to colleagues and stakeholders, often finding unexpected ways to improve bills with amendments, making them more fair. I had to make many difficult decisions on which way to vote based on research, conversations, precedent, and best possible outcome for the community at large. All these skills are directly applicable to the Justice Court bench so that I can be effective from Day One, and even more effective the more I learn.

Since my childhood I have been deeply dedicated to fairness and justice. My next-door neighbor was a retired superior court judge who took me under his wing and taught me the foundations of our judicial system and how the proper application of laws can create a good outcome even in difficult circumstances.

Weddings aside, most people who show up in a courtroom are not happy to be there. At the outset of any proceeding, it is often not obvious how a fair outcome can be obtained. In my mind, a good judge can find that outcome by applying the law through the filter of three key values: Humility, curiosity, and empathy.

Humility involves acknowledging, then pushing aside, one's own ego, prejudices, and assumptions, and then carefully listening to both sides. I know I do not know everything; I know that I will create a better judgment if I stay open and hear what both parties are saying in the context of the law.

Curiosity is key to being fully engaged; active engagement enables a good decision. It drives good research, good questions, and unexpected answers. If you are not curious, you will not be capable of learning something new that could make all the difference to the outcome.

Empathy must be a main ingredient in all decisions. I imagine myself in the place of all parties to a case, even when that may initially seem difficult. I understand the pain of being accused of something you did not do, and am dedicated to the bedrock American principle of presumption of innocence. I also understand what it feels like to be wronged by another's actions and that desire for justice. Only by seeking to understand both sides, along with the language of statute, can a judge obtain a fair outcome.

The opportunity to transition from making laws to applying them, through the lens of my foundational value of fairness, leverages my life experiences for the good of our community. I will dedicate myself — with humility, curiosity, and empathy — to the pursuit of justice for all those I serve.
