



SNAP Changes & Impact

- More Pima residents are subject to Able-Bodied Adults without Dependent (ABAWD) work requirement
 - Expands to include:
 - Older adults **until they turn 65**
 - **Parents or grandparents of children 14 or older**
 - Arizonans living in counties outside of Maricopa
 - Ends Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023 exclusions for:
 - Veterans
 - People experiencing homelessness
 - Foster Youth under 24

Ends SNAP eligibility exemptions for:

- Refugees
- People granted asylum
- Certain victims of labor or sex trafficking
- Certain victims of domestic violence
- Other previously eligible immigrants with a lawful status
