ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION and/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - \_\_\_\_, An ordinance of the Pima County Board of Supervisors, regulating parking on Esperanza Boulevard in Pima County, Arizona. Staff recommends **APPROVAL**. (District 4)

The reason for this ordinance is to adjust the limits of the existing parking regulations to conform to the new layout of Esperanza Boulevard following a road diet. Parking on the north and south sides of Esperanza Boulevard to be regulated as No Parking between Camino Holgado and approximately 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive and as No Parking from 6:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M. between 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive and La Cañada Drive.

The road diet will reduce the number of travel lanes on Esperanza Boulevard between La Cañada Drive and approximately 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive from four to two. The former travel lanes will be converted to designated parking areas and a bicycle lane. Between 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive and Camino Holgado, a paved shoulder/bicycle lane will be added.

Traffic Engineering has been communicating with the Traffic and Arroyos Committee regularly regarding these parking regulations. The Committee and public have been involved.


IF APPROVED:

Parking shall be regulated as No Parking on the north and south sides of Esperanza Boulevard between Camino Holgado and 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive and as No Parking between 6:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. from 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive and La Cañada Drive. Ordinance numbers 1985-105, 1985-139, and 1985-148 shall be repealed. The appropriate parking regulation signs are installed because the road diet project has already been completed.

IF DENIED:

Parking shall continue to be regulated on Esperanza Boulevard between Camino Holgado and La Cañada Drive through ordinance numbers 1985-105, 1985-139, and 1985-148. These ordinances shall not be repealed and the new parking regulation signs will be removed/relocated to reflect parking regulation boundaries in the above ordinances.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2015-\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULATING PARKING ON ESPERANZA BOULEVARD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-873, as amended, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is in the interest of public safety that vehicles should not park on portions of Esperanza Boulevard from Camino Holgado to La Cañada Drive,

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

**SECTION 1.** Parking on both the north and south sides of Esperanza Boulevard shall be regulated as follows:

- A. From Camino Holgado to approximately 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive it shall be regulated No Parking.
- B. From 400 feet west of Desert Bell Drive to La Cañada Drive it shall be regulated No Parking between 6:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M.

**SECTION 2.** Ordinance 1985-105, 1985-139, and 1985-148 are repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highway herein listed giving notice of the parking restriction.

**SECTION 4.** Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

**SECTION 5.** The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.




