Pima Early Education Program (PEEP)

***Purpose:**

This IGA was originally submitted and approved by the Pima County Board of Supervisors on May 6, 2025. However, we are resubmitting this revised contract amendment because the City of Tucson is reducing the amount of funds that they will be contributing to the program.

The purpose of this IGA is to extend the term by one year, increase funding to the Pima Early Education Program to sustain at least two high quality preschool classes at school district sites within the City and offer high quality preschool opportunities to families with incomes at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

To increase the number of 3 – 5 year old children from income eligible families attending high quality preschools in Pima County. To increase the number and capacity of high quality preschool providers in the community.

***Public Benefit:**

A wealth of research and data shows that investing in high quality preschool, especially for economically disadvantaged, minority, and dual language children, provides both short-term and lasting benefits to the children enrolled, their families, employers, taxpayers and the community.

AMENDMENT FOUR

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced Intergovernmental Agreement as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

1.1. Background. On May 18, 2021, Pima County ("County") and the City of Tucson ("City"), entered into the above-referenced Intergovernmental Agreement ("Agreement") to provide funding for the Pima Early Education Program.

1.2. Purpose. The parties want to extend the term by one year, contribute additional funding to the Pima Early Education Program to sustain at least two high quality preschool classes at school district sites within the City, to offer high quality preschool opportunities, without cost, to families with incomes at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level.

2. Term. This Amendment No. 4 commences on September 2, 2025 and terminates on September 1, 2026. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.

3. City Responsibilities. Section 3 of fully executed agreement (05/18/21) is amended to include City's additional contribution of \$ 320,000.00 on or before September 30, 2025 in no more than two payments.

4. County Responsibilities. Section 4 is revised to add the following paragraph:

For Year Five, FY26, children from families within incomes at or below 300 percent of the Federal Poverty Level are eligible for full or partial assistance. The participating school districts for Year 5 (FY26) include Sunnyside Unified School District and Amphitheater Unified School District and include two and a half (2.5) direct funded preschool classes. County will provide City with copies of the IGAs between County and these school districts prior to City making payment to County. County will not charge City an administrative fee for

allocating the City funds. For each year, County shall provide quarterly reports to City on or before October 31, January 31, April 30, and July 31, and will also provide an end-of-year report by September 1. Reports shall include, for the preceding quarter, the amount of City funding spent, and number of children served per school district.

5. **Counterparts.** This Amendment No. 4 may be executed in counterparts, each of which, when taken together, will constitute one original contract.

All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.


