***Project Title/Description:**

Intergovernmental Agreement between Superior Court of Arizona and Pima County for Co-location of Computing and Network Equipment

***Purpose:**

In 2010, the Superior Court Arizona in Pima County, Pima County Justice Court and Pima County agreed to co-locate their computing systems in a common physical area, creating a Court Data Center located on the sixth floor of the Administration West Building at 150 West Congress Street to reduce costs to the County for cooling and securing such operations. The agreement as updated in 2016 and has been renewed every two years. Superior Court and Justice Court have since consolidated their IT functions and Justice Court is no longer a party to this agreement. This amendment acknowledges the consolidation and exercises the last remaining two-year renewal option set out in the 2016 agreement, extending the agreement to August 14, 2026.

***Procurement Method:**

This IGA is a non-Procurement contract and not subject to Procurement rules.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

The goal of this agreement is to provide Superior Court with a location for their equipment that is already being cooled and monitored by Pima County Information Technology, which reduces overall costs to the County.

***Public Benefit:**

There are continued cost savings on cooling and security for this critical equipment.

***Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

Pima County shall assure that all equipment and data for Superior Court will be kept separate from that of the County. Court staff will be responsible for the inventory and tagging of all equipment. Installation or removal of equipment from the Court Data Center shall be at the discretion of Court staff. County staff will be made aware of changes to ensure the availability of power and cooling for other tenants isn't compromised.

**Intergovernmental Agreement
Between Superior Court of Arizona
and Pima County
For Co-Location of Computing and Network Equipment
CONTRACT AMENDMENT**

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

1.1. Background. On August 15, 2016, the Arizona Superior Court in Pima County (Superior Court or Court), Pima County Consolidated Justice Court (Justice Court) and Pima County (County) entered into the above referenced Intergovernmental Agreement to create a Court Data Center located on the 6th floor of the Administration West Building located at 150 W. Congress Street to reduce costs to the County for cooling and securing such operations. Superior Court and Justice Court have since consolidated their IT functions and Justice Court is no longer a party to this Agreement. Any references to Justice Court in the Agreement are deemed to refer to Superior Court only.

1.2. Purpose. The Court continues to need use of the Court Data Center for an additional two-year period.

2. Term. The parties are exercising the fourth extension option to renew the contract for one additional two-year period commencing on August 15, 2024, and terminating on August 14, 2026. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.

3. Security Cameras. The parties amend Section 2 of the IGA to delete the following bullet text:

Recordings that spool to Central IT maintained servers to which Court IT has access. Court IT will be responsible for copying the recordings to court systems. Recordings will be purged bi-weekly.

4. **Court IT Staff.** Any reference to Court staff in the Agreement will be deemed to be a reference to Court IT staff. The Director of Court IT, or their designee, is hereby designated as the appropriate representative to receive notice and provide approval or authorization from the Court as described in the Agreement.
5. **Equipment.** The parties have revised the equipment list as described in the attached **Exhibit A**.

All other provisions of the Agreement not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.




