To the Pima County Board of Supervisors:

Many original board members/volunteers of the Cactus Drive-In Theater Foundation DO NOT support Demion Clinco for Senator. We feel strongly that Demion Clinco is one of the main reasons for the stagnation of the Cactus Drive-In Theater Foundation, despite the support and dedication of hundreds of Tucson citizens who worked for this project to succeed.

Please read through this list of grievances against Demion Clinco's abilities as a leader, as evidenced by experience with the Cactus Drive-In Theater Foundation.

- Demion Clinco took full credit with the media for rescuing the largest screen from the DeAnza lot (at that time, he had not yet joined the Cactus Drive-In Theater Foundation; it was Charles Spillar who saved the screen).
- Demion Clinco repeatedly neglected the grass roots, family-oriented movement that had sparked the drive-in revival, instead insisting on "historic films." The first Cactus Drive-In fundraiser was run by Charles Spillar in July 2011, showed Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs, and brought in over 200 vehicles! When Charles resigned and Demion took over fundraising efforts, the films that Demion chose included Forbidden Planet and Frankenstein, the latter bringing in a mere six cars. This is clear evidence that Demion will neglect his constituents in favor of his personal interests.
- Demion Clinco insisted that the new Drive-In be built at a location on Oracle Road, not because it would be in the best interests of the drive-in (the lot has been forever tied up in red tape, and doesn't even have enough space for a single screen venue!), but because Demion is personally invested in the property and location (which are tied to his ongoing project to save Tucson's old neon signs).
- Demion Clinco seemed to have an acute disregard for the dozens of volunteers helping the Drive-In Theater Foundation. Several volunteers cited Demion Clinco as the primary reason they resigned. By December 2011 all but one volunteer had resigned their position. It is likely that Demion will treat his political subordinates in a similarly disrespectful manner.
- George Cohn, the original treasurer of the Cactus Drive-In Theater Foundation, resigned in September 2011, but is still storing the pieces of the DeAnza screen on his land. Cohn has repeatedly requested that the pieces be removed (including a certified letter) as he is no longer supportive of the project, but Demion has neglected the pieces, leaving them to rust beyond usability. So, the screen which Clinco wrongfully claimed to have singlehandedly saved has been neglected to the point of no return by its "savior." The decay of this screen mirrors the decay of Demion's Integrity in the eyes of all involved in this project.

 Two years after George Cohn and Charles Spillar resigned their board positions, Demion and the Cactus Drive-In Theater Foundation continued to fraudulently list them as board members, in addition to missing all of their filing deadlines until they were threatened with dissolution of the corporation. (This can be verified via the Arizona Corporation Commission's Public Access System.)

The negligence with which Demion Clinco and his cohorts have managed this nonprofit is inexcusable. Based on our personal experience with Demion, we feel that selecting Demion as the replacement State Senator is a grave mistake. We urge you to reconsider.
