The Information Technology Department requests to contract with Nextel Operations, Inc. aka Sprint Corporation to provide professional services to complete the mandatory, 800 MHz Rebanding Project. As the deadline approaches to complete the project, the IT Department finds sufficient need for Nextel/Sprint's specialized expertise in order to comply with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Report and Order, FCC 04-168, in WT Docket 02-55 as modified in the Supplemental Order, FCC 04-294 (together, "the Report and Order"). In accordance with the Report and Order, all costs associated with this project are borne by Sprint/Nextel; reimbursement to the County for labor and related expenses estimated at \$10,830.15.

The Information Technology Department respectfully requests authorization to contract with Nextel Operations, Inc. to provide the necessary skills and capabilities to perform related professional/consultative services in completing the 800 MHz Rebanding Project. A competitive bid process ultimately would not produce another vendor with the requisite technical and support expertise/knowledge, or comparable costs to successfully perform the required service.

Due to the urgency of this project, the Information Technology Department respectfully requests placement of this Agreement on the Board of Supervisors' addendum for the meeting on January 21, 2014.
