Contractor will continue to act as the County's bond counsel in connection with the issuance of GO Bonds, HURF Revenue Bonds, certificates-

of-participation, and sewer obligations.

*Procurement Method:

Legal services for pending or anticipated litigation are exempt under Procurement code 11.04.020.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

Contractor will continue to provide various types of assistance in connection with County bond issuances, including: allocation and coordination of the responsibilities of the issuance team, drafting and dissemination of the calendar of activities, advising County on estimating the timing of each issue, advising County on restrictions in any bond indentures and the maturity and interest-payment structures, assisting in the preparation, assembly, printing, and dissemination of the official statement and related documents, assisting in the procurement of bond ratings, advertising and dissemination of the Notice of Sale, insuring that all steps are properly followed in the issuance of the bonds, and coordinating the bond closing.

*Public Benefit:

In order to issue bonds, the County must retain nationally recognized bond counsel to issue a bond opinion. Bond counsel also ensures that the County complies with the complex state and federal statutes applicable to bond issuances and post-issuance compliance, including federal tax regulations and securities regulations. The assistance of outside counsel is therefore necessary for the County to issue bonds. Because the attorneys at Squire Patton Boggs are familiar with the County's bond program, as well as other aspects of the County's financial operation, they are able to provide this assistance efficiently and effectively.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Contractor will invoice County on a monthly basis unless a different billing period is set forth. County must receive invoices no more than 30 days after the end of the billing period in which Contractor delivered the invoiced products or services to County.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT #7

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

- 1.1. Background. On January 2, 2018, County and Contractor entered into the above referenced agreement to provide Bond Counsel. Contractor is a nationally recognized bond counsel, is familiar with state and federal requirements related to the issuance of various types of financial obligations and is very familiar with the County's bonding program.
- 1.2. Purpose. County requires continuing services and requires additional time and funding to perform those services, commencing January 2, 2024.
- 2. **Term.** The parties agree to extend the contract term for one additional year commencing on January 2, 2024 and terminating on January 1, 2025. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.
- 3. Maximum Payment Amount. The maximum amount the County will spend under this Contract, as set forth in Section 5.2, is increased by \$250,000.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$1,850,000.00.
- 4. 4.1 Rates. The parties have revised Section 4.1 Rates to include the following language:

Contractor will notify County in writing if Contractor intends to use attorneys or staff not previously listed on the Contract, and before Contractor invoices County pursuant to Section 4.5.

All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.
