***Purpose:**

Amendment #3 will extend the contract to June 30, 2022 so Emerge! can provide services for those referred through the APRAIS referral protocol, a mandated domestic violence risk assessment implemented by the Arizona Superior Court.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

To ensure people experiencing domestic violence referred through the APRAIS protocol are provided with priority services, including: crisis intervention; safety planning; emotional support; emergency shelter; domestic abuse, legal, and life-skills education; children's services; and other basic health and safety needs.

***Public Benefit:**

Research demonstrates access to support services is a critical factor in reducing domestic violence fatalities. Ensuring victims that demonstrate a high or elevated risk of lethal outcomes receive a full range of crisis and support services is imperative to saving lives and improving public safety.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

1.1. Background. On 10/01/2018, County and Contractor entered into the above referenced agreement to provide social services and emergency shelter as needed to victims of domestic abuse referred through the Arizona Intimate Partner Risk Assessment Instrument System (APRAIS).

1.2. Purpose. County requires services for an additional year.

2. Term. The County is exercising the third extension option to renew the contract for one additional year commencing on July 1, 2021 and terminating on June 30, 2022. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.

3. Maximum Payment Amount. The maximum amount the County will spend under this Contract is increased by \$100,000.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$400,000.00.

All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.


