Dear Award Recipient:

Your agency's COPS Hiring Award 2020ULWX0016 is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2023. The COPS Office will initiate an automatic 12-month no-cost extension for your award, for the reasons outlined below.

To fully implement a COPS Hiring Program award, each COPS-funded position must be filled for a total of 36 months during the award period of performance. Once the 36-month funding period is satisfied, the position must remain filled using local funding for an additional 12 month retention period. Many FY2020 award recipients are unable to meet the 36-month requirement by June 2023, due to the challenges faced during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- 1. If you agree with this extension, <u>no action is required</u>. The new end date of your award will be June 30, 2024.
- 2. If you do not need this extension, or would like to discuss the period of performance, please contact your Grant Manager by May 15, 2023.
