Title: Knollwood Drive at the Avilla Sabino East Driveway Yield Ordinance

Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Traffic Engineering Division received a citizen request to review the traffic control at the intersection of Knollwood Drive and the Avilla Sabino East driveway, located approximately 300 feet east of Sabino Canyon Road. Knollwood Drive is a local road with a 25 mph speed limit; the Avilla Sabino East driveway is a private driveway.

Discussion:

In response to the citizen request, Pima County Traffic Engineering Division staff conducted a field review of the intersection. An uncontrolled traffic circle is currently installed at the intersection.

Conclusion:

Following the field review, it was determined that all-way-yield control was recommended to improve the operation and establish right-of-way at the traffic circle.

Recommendation:

The Pima County Traffic Engineering Division recommends approval to designate the intersection of Knollwood Drive and the Avilla Sabino East driveway, located approximately 300 feet east of Sabino Canyon Road, as an all-way-yield intersection.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-___

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF KNOLLWOOD DRIVE AND THE AVILLA SABINO EAST DRIVEWAY IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-855 as amended, to designate and establish yield intersections and to erect yield signs, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is necessary for the protection and convenience of the traveling public of Pima County, Arizona, to establish the intersection of Knollwood Drive and the Avilla Sabino East driveway, located approximately 300 feet east of Sabino Canyon Road, as an all-way-yield intersection,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The intersection of Knollwood Drive and the Avilla Sabino East driveway, located approximately 300 feet east of Sabino Canyon Road, be designated as an all-way-yield intersection.

SECTION 2. Any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that yield signs are posted on the intersecting streets.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
