CONTRACT AMENDMENT # 6

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

1.1. <u>Background</u>. On August 28, 2020, County and Contractor entered into the above referenced agreement to provide representation of Pima County and Mark Napier in *Murillo v. Pima County, et al.*, C20201462.

1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. County requires continuing services and requires additional funds to perform those services, commencing August 19, 2024.

- 2. Maximum Payment Amount. The maximum amount the County will spend under this Contract, as set forth in Section 5.2, is increased by \$20,000.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$375,000.00.
- 3. 3.3 In an unexpected circumstance or emergency, Contractor may substitute another suitably trained and skilled attorney from the same law firm to complete a one-time or short-term task.
- 4. 4.5 Invoices. The parties have revised Section 4.5 Invoices to include the following language:

The Pima County Attorney's Office (PCAO) reserves the right to review invoices for mathematical errors, duplicative billing, and attorney training time (including time for alternative attorneys to catch up on cases or matters for which they must read and conduct research in order to substitute for the original attorney where the original named attorney is not available). PCAO reserves the right to refuse payment for such items that lack a reasonable explanation. While it may be reasonable to pay for initial famillarization with an individual case, County will not pay such expenses for a second or third time if, for reasons beyond its control, the case is transferred to another attorney within the contracting attorney's law firm. Additionally, PCAO reserves the right to refuse payment for invoiced services for Key Personnel not listed on this Contract.

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All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.
