I support Supervisor Christy's request to understand how the recipients of these special premiums were determined as "essential" and who determined which "essential" employee got what amount.

Agenda item #15 & Addendum item #3 : Presentation on "Poverty in Tucson" & Pandemic Response Task Force Discussion/Direction/Action

I want Pima County to use the free state auditor general or, at a minimum, a certified auditor to look at what percentage of people lost their jobs and fell into poverty during the pandemic as a direct result of Pima County's aggressive shutdown of small- and medium-sized businesses. Request the board to include the number of lost jobs, pensions, benefits, and homes that the vaccine mandates caused as well as analysis on the increase in drug addiction, drug overdoses, youth suicides, and homelessness.

Addendum item #4: Recommended COVID-19 Vaccine Mandate for Election Workers.

The COVID-19 negative test requirement and \$50 stipend are ridiculous considering the vaccinated get COVID-19 and spread it, too. There is absolutely no difference between the vaccinated and unvaccinated getting and spreading COVID-19, so neither group should be treated differently.
