## **PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, each April we observe Workers' Memorial Day as a day to remember those who have suffered from serious injuries and died from preventable workplace hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, there were 103 preventable workplace fatalities and 80,000 serious workplace injuries in Arizona in 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, we need to remember these workers who died in workplace catastrophes, suffered diseases because of toxic-substance exposures, or were injured fatally because of dangerous workplace conditions including the COVID-19 virus and excessive heat; and

**WHEREAS**, the core theme for Workers' Memorial Day is that most of these tragedies were preventable as we rededicate ourselves to the fight for safe workplaces rights; and

**WHEREAS**, Workers' Memorial Day is celebrated around the globe in nearly 100 countries.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims Sunday, April 28, 2024, to be:

### "WORKERS' MEMORIAL DAY"

and urges all County residents to join in remembering workers who have perished or been injured as a result of preventable workplace hazards, and their families who strive to make sure that dangerous workplaces don't adversely affect other workers and families.
