Title: Resolution No. 2018 to disband the Pima County/O Prevention and Treatment and repeal Resolution Nos. 2	city of Tucson Commission of 2001-244, 2002-322, and 20	on Addiction, 006-297		
Introduction/Background:				
On October 9, 2001, the Pima County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2001-244 to establish the Pima County/City of Tucson Commission on Addition, Prevention and Treatment ("Committee"). Resolution No. 2001-244 was subsequently repealed in Resolution Nos. 2002-322 and 2006-297. The Committee was implemented to inform and educate the community, advise elected officials and provide recommendations to key stakeholders on the prevention and treatment of substance abuse and addition.				
Discussion:  This Commission has insufficient membership to establish a quorum, as 16 of the 19 memberships are expired or vacant. According to the Committee's bylaws, a "quorum of 10 must always be present to hold a meeting, even if there are vacant member slots." Therefore, the Board would like to disband the Commission. The City of Tucson also plans to disband the Commission.				
Conclusion:				
Due to insufficient membership and no quorum, the Commission should be disbanded.				
Recommendation:  The Board of Supervisors recommends  1) repealing Resolution Nos. 2001-244, 2002-322, and 2006-297; and  2) approval of Resolution No. 2018 to disband the Pima County/City of Tucson Commission on Addiction, Prevention and Treatment due to insufficient membership to constitute a quorum.  This resolution is effective on the effective date of a like resolution adopted by the City of Tucson.

RESOLUTION OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DISBANDING THE PIMA COUNTY/CITY OF TUCSON COMMISSION ON ADDICTION, PREVENTION AND TREATMENT AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NOS. 2001-244, 2002-322, AND 2006-297

## The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona finds:

- 1. On October 9, 2001, the Pima County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2001-244, to establish the Pima County/City of Tucson Commission on Addition, Prevention and Treatment ("the Commission").
- 2. The Board of Supervisors subsequently amended Resolution No. 2001-244 in Resolution Nos. 2002-322 and 2006-297.
- 3. The Commission for some time has had insufficient membership to constitute a quorum, and the Board of Supervisors now desires to disband the Commission, effective upon like action being taken by the City of Tucson.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

**Section 1.** The Commission is disbanded as of the effective date of this Resolution, and from and after that date no longer exists.

**Section 2.** Resolution Nos. 2001-144, 2002-322, and 2006-297 are repealed as of the effective date of this Resolution.

**Section 3.** This Resolution is effective on the effective date of a like resolution adopted by the City of Tucson.
