RESOLUTION: P23CA00002 SBH SENDERO LP – REPEAL OF REZONING POLICY RP-110 AJO HIGHWAY / VALENCIA ROAD PLAN AMENDMENT

*Introduction/Background:

The Board of Supervisors approved the comprehensive plan amendment on September 5, 2023.

*Discussion:

The comprehensive plan amendment repeals Rezoning Policy RP-110 as these policies have been included the Sendero Pass Specific Plan. The policy covers approximately 883.30 acres on parcels 209-15-006J, 209-15-006L, 209-15-006M, 209-15-006P, 209-16-006H and 209-16-006J located south and west of the intersection of W. Ajo Highway and W. Valencia Road, in Sections 13 and 14, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, in the Southwest Planning Area. The repeal grants the property owner the ability to follow-up with a Specific Plan amendment allowing light industrial/employment uses or to update the current uses to better address current market demands. This amendment does not change the Planned Development Community (PDC) land use designation.

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A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA; RELATING TO PLANNING; AMENDING THE PIMA COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN LAND USE MAP, IN P23CA00002 SBH SENDERO LP – REPEAL OF REZONING POLICY RP-110 AJO HIGHWAY / VALENCIA ROAD PLAN AMENDMENT, FOR APPROXIMATELY 883.30 ACRES ON PARCELS 209-15-006J, 209-15-006L, 209-15-006M, 209-15-006P, 209-16-006H AND 209-16-006J LOCATED SOUTH AND WEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF W. AJO HIGHWAY AND W. VALENCIA ROAD, IN SECTIONS 13 AND 14, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, IN THE SOUTHWEST PLANNING AREA.

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Pima County Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map, Southwest Planning Area, is hereby amended to repeal Rezoning Policy RP-110 Ajo Highway / Valencia Road, with the planned land use intensity category to remain Planned Development Community on approximately 883.30 acres, as referenced in P23CA00002 SBH Sendero LP – Repeal of Rezoning Policy RP-110 Ajo Highway / Valencia Road Plan Amendment, located south and west of the intersection of W. Ajo Highway and W. Valencia Road, in Sections 13 and 14, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, as shown on the map attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Pima County Comprehensive Plan Regional, Special Area and Rezoning Policies, Rezoning Policy RP-110 Ajo Highway / Valencia Road is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> The various County officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective on the date of adoption.
