## **PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, more than 43 million Americans cannot read or write at the most basic level, while 62.7 million lack basic math skills as well as the credentials and skills necessary to succeed in post-secondary education; and

**WHEREAS**, more than 900,000 Arizona adults 18 years or older need Adult Education to help them complete a high school equivalency diploma or to learn English; and

**WHEREAS**, 10.1% of Pima County adults 25 years and older do not have a high school diploma; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Action Forum estimates that America is short an estimated 7.5 million private sector workers across all skill levels; and

**WHEREAS**, Adult Education programs contribute to solving these challenges by helping Americans move along the continuum in their educational journey to achieve basic skills and get prepared for careers and college; and

**WHEREAS**, Adult Education programs offer low-cost, high-value programs that upgrade the skill set of our citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, Pima County, Arizona celebrates National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week as a proud participant in the national Educate & Elevate Campaign, which helps our citizens learn about all of their Adult Education options to attain their professional and personal goals.
