PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, for over three decades, Mariscos Chihuahua has been a beloved culinary institution in Tucson, introducing generations of residents and visitors to the rich flavors of authentic Mexican-style seafood since opening its doors on July 12, 1994, under the care and vision of the Preciado family; and

WHEREAS, founded originally in Nogales, Mexico, in 1971, Mariscos Chihuahua has grown into a Tucson landmark, cherished for its community-rooted hospitality, family traditions, and cultural contributions to Southern Arizona's vibrant food scene; and

WHEREAS, the restaurant is famed for signature dishes like its Shrimp Culichi, celebrated by The New York Times for its distinctive poblano cream sauce, and its ceviche, which has drawn lines of loyal customers at events such as Tucson Meet Yourself, selling over 500 pounds in a single day; and

WHEREAS, the Preciado family has built a multi-generational legacy of culinary excellence by maintaining consistency, sourcing quality ingredients, and forging strong ties with local vendors and communities; and

WHEREAS, through 31 years in Tucson, Mariscos Chihuahua has embodied resilience, pride, and innovation, expanding its legacy through additional family-run locations while staying true to its Barrio Hollywood roots.
