WHEREAS, Glaz-Tech's story is not just one of growth, but of resilience and reinvestment — continuously upgrading technologies, expanding capabilities, and creating good-paying jobs for more than 270 employees across the Southwest, all while nurturing a workplace culture built on pride, care, and respect; and

WHEREAS, the company remains deeply rooted in Tucson and continues to reflect the values we hold dear — innovation, hard work, and the power of local leadership with a national impact.
